PAS Agencies: PAS Agencies are ISC's (Independent Service Coordinator's). They become the advocate for families looking for services for loved ones.

PAS agencies...

- · Are based on the current county the individual lives in
- · Screen individuals to determine eligibility for Illinois services/funding
- Educate individuals and families, provide resources, and assist with the service selection process
- Determine which services are needed for individuals which are established through the assessments and evaluations
- · Gather and supply all documentation/information needed to support PAS/ISC determination to potential and/or current service providers
- Provides 24-hour help
