Prairie State Legal Services — Equal Access to Justice

What is Prairie State Legal Services?

Prairie State Legal Services, Inc. is a nonprofit law firm that provides civil legal aid at no charge for eligible persons. Prairie State has 12 offices serving 36 counties throughout Northern and Central Illinois, except Cook County.

Who is eligible?

Generally, persons must have low income and limited assets to be eligible for services, but special funding from the Older Americans Act enables Prairie State to expand the services available to persons age 60 and older without regard to income or assets. Prairie State cannot help everyone, so legal services are focused on helping older adults resolve legal problems affecting access to basic health care, income, housing, and safety.

What types of cases can Prairie State handle?

Prairie State helps older adults with civil legal matters such as:

- Denials or reductions in needed health care including Medicare, Medicaid, and home care services
- Public benefits, such as TANF, Food Stamps (SNAP), and Social Security/SSI
- · Domestic violence and elder abuse
- Nursing home or supported living facility involuntary discharges
- · Debt problems and utility shut-offs
- Evictions, denials of housing, and mortgage foreclosures
- Legal advice and brief services may be available in other situations including consumer and tax problems, powers of attorney, guardianships, and many other eligible cases.

Persons aged 55 and older who are raising children due to the inability or unwillingness of the parent to care for their children may be eligible for legal services. Call your local office of Prairie State.

Prairie State DOES NOT handle criminal cases, traffic cases, personal injury cases, complex estate planning, or probate cases.
